Britain's 300,000 Gypsies, Roma and Travellers have lived, worked and travelled throughout Britain for over 500 years, yet they have been almost entirely written out of British history.

GRTHM celebrates culture and history by tackling the negative stereotyping and prejudices that have led to this situation. It is a partnership between communities and those in local and central government who want to help.

Summer Solstice or Midsummer (Pagan)

Pagans celebrate Midsummer or Litha, which means 'standing still of the sun'.

25th

Ratha Yatra (Hindu)

Means 'chariot festival' and is a Hindu festival traditionally celebrated in Orissa State.

Eid-al-Fitr (Muslim)

Marks the end of the month-long fast during the Islamic month of Ramadan.
